1	the oral argument of counsel for all parties,	
2	IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED:	
3	1. The petition for writ of mandate is GRANTED for the following reasons:	
4	a. The Petition for Writ of Mandate challenged Respondent California Fish and	
5	Game Commission's (Commission) decision to deny Petitioner's petition, filed on	
6	January 23, 2008, to list the fisher as either threatened or endangered under the	
7	California Endangered Species Act (CESA; Fish & G. Code, § 2050 et seq.,) and	
8	Respondent Department of Fish and Game's (Department) failure to perform its	
9	non-discretionary duty to "solicit independent and competent peer review of the	
10	department's status report whenever possible." (Cal. Code. Reg., § 670.1, subd.	
11	(f)(2); Fish & G. Code, § 2074.6.)	
12	b. The Commission voted to reject Petitioner's petition on June 23, 2010, and	
13	adopted its Notice of Findings in support thereof on September 15, 2010.	
14	c. As set forth in the Notice of Findings, in reaching its decision, the Commission	
15	failed to proceed in a manner required by law by:	
16	Relying on a Status Report prepared by the Department that was not peer	
17	reviewed, as required by California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section	
18	670.1(f)(2), and Fish and Game Code section 2074.6, or "based upon the	
19	best scientific information available," as required by Fish and Game Code	
20	section 2074.6. This violation constitutes a prejudicial abuse of discretion.	
21	(Code Civ. Proc., §1094.5, subd. (b).)	
22	d. In addition, the Department failed to perform its mandatory duty to "seek	
23	independent and competent peer review of the department status report whenever	
24	possible," as required by California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section	
25	670.1(f)(2), and Fish and Game Code section 2074.6. This violation of law	
26	constitutes a failure to "perform[] an act which the law specifically enjoins."	
27	(Code Civ. Proc., § 1085, subd. (a).)	
28	2. A writ of mandamus shall issue from this court, remanding the proceedings to	

1	Respondents for further proceedings in accordance with this Order. Specifically, the writ	
2	shall order:	
3	a. the Department to solicit independent and competent peer review of the	
4	Department's Status Report and recommendation whether listing the fisher is	
5	warranted; and	
6	b. the Commission to set aside its Notice of Findings and to reconsider its decision	
7	in light of this Order, after receipt of the Department's properly peer reviewed	
8	Status Report.	
9	3. Petitioner may submit a Memorandum of Costs and request for attorney's fees.	
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11	Petitioner's counsel should submit a proposed writ in accordance with this order.
