This is a photo of backpumped water from pumping station S-2 (on the right) compared to normal Lake Okeechobee water (on the left) taken from the scientific files of South Florida Water Management District scientist Karl Havens. Note the handwriting on the bottom of the page indicating that this is a "typical" sample. This backpumped water contaminates the drinking water of cities around the Lake that use the Lake for their public water supplies. This water looks the same as the samples brought to court by FWF's drinking water expert Dr. Bill Wise.
