Respondent California Fish and Game Commission's ("Commission") **Mo**tion for Clarification of Timing and Scope of Writ of Mandate ("Motion") came on regularly for hearing on February 8, 2013 before the Honorable Judge Harold E. Kahn in Department 302 of the above Court. All parties appeared at the hearing through counsel.

Upon consideration of the Motion, the papers submitted in response and reply to the Motion, the pleadings and records of this action, and the argument of counsel at the hearing, and for other good cause appearing, the Court adopts its revised tentative ruling of February 7, 2013 as its order: "The Commission acted in accordance with the writ and judgment by setting aside the Notice of Findings at its November 2012 meeting and that, as a result of doing so, the fisher is restored to the list of candidate species per the Commission's prior decision without need for any further action on the part of the Commission."

The adoption of the above tentative ruling as the order of the Court is **int**ended to clarify the Court's intent to restore the *status quo ante* that existed before the Commission rejected the petition to list the Pacific fisher, including reinstating the Pacific fisher's candidate status and the applicable provisions of Article 3 of the California Endangered Species Act (**Fish** & Game Code section 2080 et seq.), and is not intended to prevent the Commission from taking such further action, if any, as the Commission deems appropriate to provide notice that the **Pacific** fisher is reinstated to candidate status pending the Commission's reconsideration of a **new** peer-reviewed status report on the Pacific fisher from the Department of Fish and Wildlife, as **pr**eviously ordered by this Court, including publication of such notification in the California Regulatory Notice Register.
